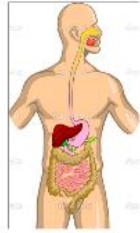

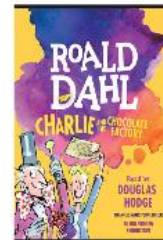

Literacy and SPaG



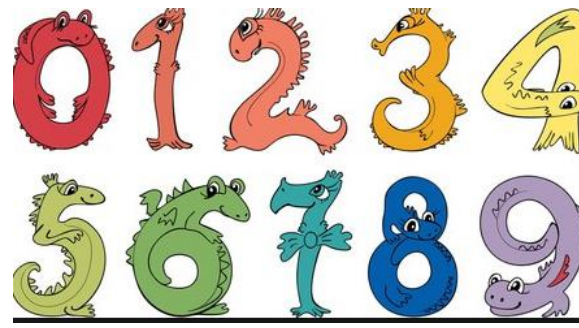
- Daily Literacy lessons are taught covering a variety of genres which are linked to our topics.
- Weekly Spelling and Grammar lessons are taught which we often link to homework tasks.
- All children need to have a BLUE handwriting pen that has flowing ink such as a Berol handwriting pen or a school one available in reception at 30p.

Reading



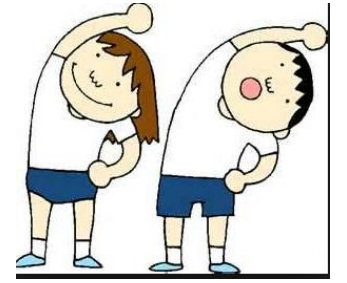
- Whole class reading is taught weekly linked to our topics.
- Adults will read regularly with each child and support their individual reading needs.
- Please ensure you are recording daily reads in your child's reading record and hand in on a Friday morning.
- Please record individual reads, even if the whole book is not complete. E.g. p4-8 on that day.
- Reading books need to be changed independently by children, when they have finished a book.

Maths



- Daily Maths lessons are taught following the White Rose scheme of work. This is being implemented to help to further develop children's reasoning and problem solving skills.
- Children are being encouraged to talk about their Maths and explain reasons behind their answers and ways of thinking. Please encourage this at home!
- We are continuing to use Times Tables Rockstars. Please access this at home for your children to play and practise! We focus on the 3s, 4s and 8s in Year 3. In addition to the 2s, 5s and 10s they learnt in Year 2.
- By the end of Year 4, the children will sit a national times tables test up to 12×12 .

PE



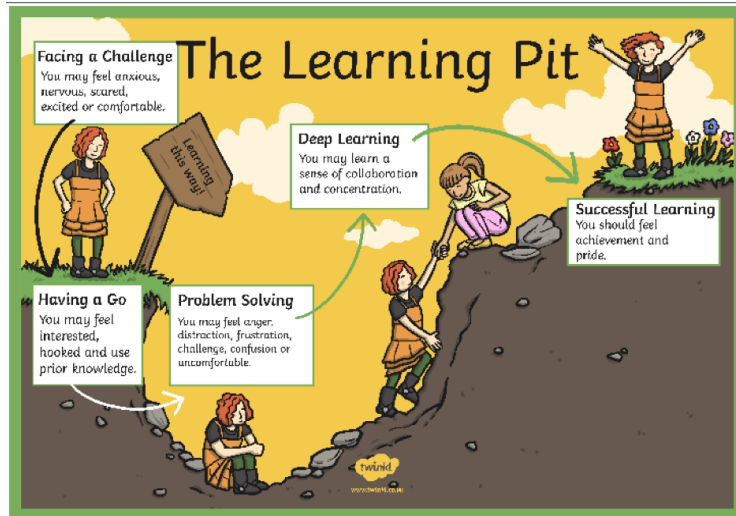
- Indoor PE kit(Friday)- white top, black shorts

Resist the easy option!

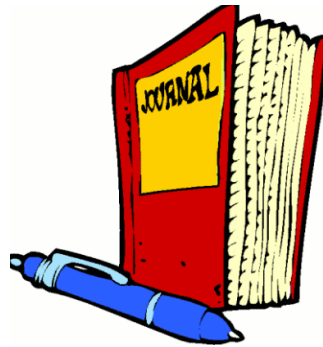


Independence

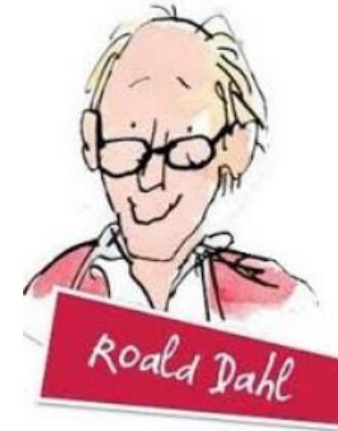
