In partnership with the Tall Ships Youth Trust (TSYT), the Naval Children's Charity are offering a once in a lifetime opportunity for young people of Naval families, serving or veteran, in 2023.

We are on the lookout for the explorers of tomorrow to take part in a thrilling sea adventure along the coast of the British Isles on board one of the TSYT's iconic 72ft Challenger yachts. Participants would also have an opportunity to achieve their RYA Competent Crew Certificate and, if appropriate, contribute towards the Gold Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme. Voyage 1 (ages 12-15)

Departs from Portsmouth Tuesday 1st August.

Arrives in Plymouth Saturday 5th August.

Voyage 2 (ages 12-15)

Departs from Plymouth Monday 7th August.

Arrives in Portsmouth Friday 11th August.

Closing date: 30th June

Voyage 3 (ages 16-25)

Departs from Portsmouth Monday 16th October.

Arrives in Portsmouth Friday 20th October.

Closing date: Friday 15th September

Voyage 4 (ages 12-15)

Departs from Portsmouth Monday 23rd October.

Arrives back in Portsmouth Friday 27th October.

Closing date: Friday 15th September
