| my child has<br>COVID 19<br>(Coronavirus)<br>symptoms*                              | <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Inform school immediately</li> <li>Child should get a test</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates</li> </ul>  | when the child's test<br>comes back as negative<br>or after a minimum of 10<br>days of self-isolation  |
| my child tests<br>positive for COVID-<br>19 (Coronavirus)                           | <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Child self-isolates for 10 days from when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms*)</li> <li>Inform school immediately of the test result</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates for 14 days from day when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms*) - even if someone tests negative during those 14 days</li> </ul> | after 10 days of self-isolation and has been without a temperature for at least 48 hours.  The child may still have a cough or loss / change in sense of taste and smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone |
| somebody in the<br>household has<br>COVID-19<br>(Coronavirus)<br>symptoms*          | <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Household member with symptoms should get a test</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates while waiting for test result</li> <li>Inform school immediately about the test result</li> </ul>   | when household<br>member test is negative,<br>and child does not have<br>COVID-19 (Coronavirus)<br>symptoms*   |
| somebody in my<br>household has<br>tested positive for<br>COVID-19<br>(Coronavirus) | <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates for 14 days from day when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms) - even if someone tests negative during those 14 days</li> </ul>   | when child has<br>completed 14 days of<br>self-isolation, even if they<br>test negative during the<br>14 days  |

| NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms* or confirmed COVID-19 (Coronavirus) | <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Child self-isolates for 14 days (as advised by NHS Test and Trace) – even if they test negative during those 14 days</li> <li>The rest of the household does not need to self-isolate, unless they are a 'close contact' as well to the infected person</li> </ul>  | when the child has<br>completed 14 days of<br>self-isolation, even if they<br>test negative during those<br>14 days     |

| we / my child has<br>travelled and has<br>to self-isolate as<br>part of a period of<br>quarantine                              | <ul> <li>Do not take unauthorised leave from school in term time</li> <li>Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel to ensure time in school is not lost</li> <li>Provide information to school as per attendance policy</li> <li>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed:         <ul> <li>Child should not attend school</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates for 14 days – even if they test negative during those 14 days</li> </ul> </li> </ul> | when the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed for the child, even if they test negative during those 14 days |
| we have received<br>advice from a<br>medical / official<br>source that my<br>child must resume<br>shielding                    | Contact the school to discuss options for safe learning  | When advised by the school in consultation with other agencies as appropriate   |
| I am not sure<br>who should get a<br>test for COVID -19<br>(Coronavirus)   | <ul> <li>Only people with symptoms* need to get a test</li> <li>People without symptoms are not advised to get a test, even if they are a 'close contact' of someone who tests positive</li> </ul>   | when conditions above, as matching your situation, are met  |

## A new continuous cough means:

• You are coughing a lot for more than 1 hour



OR

• You have been coughing a lot 3 or more times in 24 hours



• If you normally have a cough, it may be worse than usual
