In my absence Mrs Nicholls and Miss Warren are always available in their role as Deputy Headteachers as is Mr Leader as Assistant Headteacher.

Last academic year, I was pleased to report a 15% increase in the number of Year 6 children leaving Goosewell Academy having met the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths ensuring more children were fully prepared for their next stage of their education. However, we must be clear that there is still work to be done and I am confident that this year we will see even more children achieve the expected standards while maintaining the positive ethos that Goosewell is known for. Therefore, as an improving school, our key priorities will continue to focus on raising standards in Reading, Writing and Maths while ensuring the children receive a knowledge and experience rich wider curriculum.

To help us understand if the changes we have implemented are having impact and to understand if the children are enjoying the work they are doing through an appropriate level of challenge, subject leaders, will throughout the year, conference the children to get their important viewpoint. It is also important that we listen to the views of parents and to help make this happen I would like to establish the Parent Forum. Ideally, this would be made up of one or two parent representatives of each class who would meet with myself once a term to informally discuss, over coffee or tea, any developments or concerns about the class or school with the aim of providing transparency about the direction of travel of the school. The date of the first Parent Forum will be Wednesday 30th October 9.00am – 10.30am. If you are interested in representing your child's class, I would be very grateful if you could send a letter to the school office outlining your interest in this position.

As always, you will find details of forthcoming events on the weekly newsletter and school calendar. I would also like to bring special attention to the first of two Parents' evenings of this year on the Tuesday 29th & Wednesday 30th of October. This year, appointments will take place after school and information on how to book your slot, using our new website, will follow shortly.

The autumn term is busy and purposeful, and I have no doubt that your children will settle well into their new routines. Personally, I am very excited to begin my first full year at Goosewell Academy and look forward to spending more time getting to know the children and the families of Goosewell.
