Pupil Premium at Goosewell Academy

Pupil Premium and Service Premium are government funds allocated to schools to support children from low income families and those who have a parent in the Armed Services. The Government provides schools with this additional funding to support the teaching and pastoral care. Pupil Premium is for children who are entitled to free school meals (FSM), children looked after by the Local Authority (LAC) and who have been adopted. Service Premium is for children of armed service personnel.

Free School Meals – regardless of entitlement to Universal Free School Meals

Families on a low income may be entitled to Free School Meals on low income grounds. If you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed below;

Income Support

Income based Job Seekers Allowance

Child Tax Credits, with NO Working Tax Credits and an annual income not exceeding £16,190

Guarantee element of Pension Credit

Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act

The Local Authority will use this information you provide to check your details using the Government's online Eligibility Checking Service (ECS).
